Development goals:

- -Increase Climate Awareness: Students will develop an understanding of climate-related issues affecting their local environment.
- -Collaborative Problem-Solving: Students will work in cooperative groups to design and conduct surveys that identify local environmental problems.
- -Data Analysis Skills: Students will learn to analyze survey data and present their findings in a clear and informative poster.
- -Raise Local Awareness: Students will increase awareness of environmental challenges within their school and community, emphasizing that local actions can contribute to global change ("Think globally, act locally").

Planning:

- Warm-up: Watch the video "How to Take Care of the Environment" to get ideas.
- Plan: In groups of 3 or 4, choose one aspect of your school or city environment that you can improve. Prepare survey questions to gather people's opinions, and use an online survey tool.
- Create: Analyze the survey results and choose different ways to present the information. This can be done using a poster or an online presentation tool (such as Canva or Glogster) to avoid using paper.
- Present: Present your findings to the class, explaining how you gathered the information, summarizing the survey results, and proposing ways to improve the chosen aspect of the environment.
