



CLIMATE PROJECT - PLANNING SHEET

Title: A video contest about overusing smart devices

Age: 11-18

Content:

Children make a 2 minute video about the topic "overconsumption on smart devices". In the video they explain why it is bad for the planet and what can they do about it. The videos will be uploaded to e.g. padlet. and the best video(s) will be awarded.

Overconsumption of smart devices drives climate change by increasing energy demand for production, data processing, and charging, leading to higher carbon emissions, but promoting energy-efficient use and longer device lifespans can help reduce this impact.

Development goals:

The students will practise working together. The students practise planning the video and being responsible for making the video. The students practice digital competence.

Planning:

- 1) Teacher divides students in groups of 4(e.g).
- 2) Teacher introduces students the video project - every group has to make a 2 minute video about overconsumption of smart devices. In the video they have to bring out why can smart devices be bad for the earth and what can be done about it. Students can be as creative about the video as they like.
- 3) Students will make the videos in groups.
- 4) Students will upload the videos to a padlet.
- 5) The jury will look over the videos and find out the best videos.
- 6) The best videos are rewarded.

Resources:

Students: a smart device with a camera or a camera. The students should already know how to use a camera and some basic video montage program.

Teacher: Ready-made padlet for uploading the videos, introductions for students.

Teacher finds the jurors to find the best video and prepare the rewards for the best videos.
