Title: To the Rescue II

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Age: 8-10

Content:

We continue the project called "To the rescue"

The second video of our planet shows us the first challenge.

The objective is to encourage and enhance good social habits among our students. (use of trash cans to keep the school clean)

We will create "playground patrols", which will have the mission of ensuring that papers are not dropped on the ground.

Development goals:

Planning:

1. Warm-up, we watch the video of the first challenge. <https://youtu.be/kWoChXpqTdA> (5 minutes)
2. Observe. We go to the playground and we take a walk in order to observe the state of the premises regarding cleanliness and trying to create the need in the students to keep it clean. (15 min)
3. Act. Brainstorm to find possible solutions to keep the playground clean. (15 minutes)
4. From this brainstorming, each group choose 10 ideas to create a decalogue. (10 minutes)
5. We make the decalogue (10 minutes)
5. We will go through the different classrooms to explain the conclusions of our decalogues and our action plan. (15 minutes)
