Title: To the Rescue III

Content:

This is the third part of the project "To the rescue". Every week the Earth sends us a video asking us for help.

The third video of our planet shows us the second challenge related to endangered animals.

The objectives are to discover endangered animals. We also want to know what aspects cause animals to become endangered and analyze how we can prevent animals from disappearing from our planet. We discover and we learn by researching and sharing information with our classmates.

Development goals:

Be aware of the situation of endangered animals, analyze it and act to improve it.

Research cooperatively to obtain information.

Raise awareness about the importance of taking care of our environment and animals.

Planning:

1. Warm-up, we watch the video of the second challenge <https://youtu.be/oiYuzgTIDDc> (5 minutes)
2. We brainstorm about when they think an animal is in danger of extinction. Brainstorming. (5 minutes)
3. In pairs, we look for information about endangered animals. They have a template to fill. (30 minutes)
4. They show the information to the classmates. (40 minutes)
5. Give Post-it to each pair and they write what their animal would say if it could speak. (10 minutes)
6. Read the reflections and hang them on the corridor walls. (5 minutes)
